

### Special Events

Contact us to host your next special event. From private group programs to fund-raisers, we have a park or facility to accommodate you. A special event permit may be required, depending on the activity planned.

Horseshoe Lake Park and Retreat offers a wide variety of outdoor activities including canoeing, swimming, fishing, and hiking, as well as a picnic area and playground. Rustic-style cabins nestled on the water banks are available for weekend or weekly rentals. Each furnished cabin includes a kitchenette with microwave, mini-fridge and four-burner gas stove; dining/living room; and screened-in porch offering delightful views of the lake. Cabins may sleep six to 10 people. Horseshoe Lake Park and Retreat is a great place for private and corporate events. The large dining room and mess hall make it ideal for family reunions, corporate functions, church outings, and weddings.

### Escape, Experience, Explore

Escape the everyday and connect with your family and neighbors through exciting sports programs, relaxing park venues, and open spaces. Experience something new though guided recreation and education programs. Explore the outdoors and swim, paddle, hike and bike your way through Marion County's unparalleled forests, trails, springs, and lakes.

Since 1953, KP Hole Park has been the year-round family destination for spending the day on the spring-fed Rainbow River. While on the 72-degree, crystal-clear river, you may encounter a variety of wildlife, including alligators, otters, birds, and fish.

The Forest Community Center at Sandhill Park is the department's first community center. Opened in 2011, the facility offers a variety of recreational programming, as well as room rentals for weddings, birthdays, family reunions and more. A pavilion, boardwalk and playground are also available.
