

RESOLUTION NO. 05-R-615

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ENGINEER TO DETERMINE DRIVEWAY ACCESS AT CORNERS AND MINIMUM DRIVEWAY SPACING; PROVIDING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ENGINEER TO DETERMINE STORMWATER DRAINAGE DESIGN SIGNAGE FOR PRIVATE RETENTION/DETENTION BASINS OR AREAS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that vested subdivision lots provide unique circumstances for driveway access at corners and minimum driveway spacing requiring numerous requests for waivers of the Code requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to increase the authority of the County Engineer and decrease the number of waiver requests presented to the Development Review Committee and this Board; and

WHEREAS, Section 8.2.5, Street Circulation/Access Management System, a(12), Driveway Access, of the County Land Development Code (Code), Driveway Access at Corners/Minimum Driveway Spacing, currently provides for determinations by the County Engineer on a case by case basis and the failure to follow minimum spacing requirements due to lot size has resulted in numerous waiver requests; and

WHEREAS, Section 8.2.9, Stormwater drainage design, d(9) of the Code currently provides requirements for signage within private retention/detention basins or areas which should be determined by the County Engineer, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida:

SECTION 1. Driveway Access. The Board hereby authorizes the County Engineer to grant written approval for Driveway Access at Corners and for minimum Driveway Spacing, consistent with traffic safety requirements with appeal to the Development Review Committee and this Board. The Board directs the amendment to the Code consistent with this authorization.

SECTION 2. Stormwater Drainage Design Signage. The Board hereby authorizes the County Engineer to grant written approval for changes to Stormwater Drainage Design Signage criteria for private retention/detention basins or areas, based on the need for such signage, with appeal to the Development Review Committee and this Board. The Board directs the amendment to the Code consistent with this authorization.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


