Marion County Board of County Commissioners hopes everyone will continue to enjoy KP Hole Park. That's why park team members have implemented a new policy of closing the park once all available parking spaces are filled. Often, visitors have used unauthorized areas to park vehicles, outside of the park's staff control.

"We're receiving complaints, that some park visitors are blocking driveways of homes neighboring the park," said Judge Cochran, Marion County Public Information Officer.

KP Hole Park is "the family destination for spending the day on the Rainbow River," said Lee Niblock, Parks and Recreation Director and Bureau Chief. "The park is open every day of the year and offers swimming, picnicking, a boat ramp, tube and canoe rentals." The park is known for its popular tube run, the "Rainbow River Classic, the tuber ride of generations." Niblock wants to ensure guests park in designated areas, most importantly for their safety, but also to be a good neighbor to those whose driveways have been blocked.

Marion County's KP Hole Park at 9435 SW 190th Avenue Road, Dunnellon, welcomes visitors to tube, float or raft *from* the park until 1:45 p.m., each day.
