SPOTTY REMINDS YOU TO STAY FIRE SAFE!

- Install dual-mode smoke alarms in every sleeping area and in common areas like hallways and living rooms; mount them high on walls or ceilings.
- Replace your smoke alarm batteries at least twice a year or when the time changes.
- Test your smoke alarms monthly to ensure they are working properly.
- Replace smoke alarms every 10 years.
- Never “borrow” batteries from your smoke alarms to power other devices because you will likely forget to replace the batteries.
- Practice fire escape plans routinely with your family by identifying two exits from every room, crawling to safety and establishing a safe meeting place outside.
- Call 911 from outside your home and never stay inside a burning building for any reason.
