Photos with people must have a release that can be provided upon request.

Entries can be printed but no larger than 11 x 14 and mounted, or unframed, stretch framed or framed. If an e-mailed or uploaded photo is chosen as a finalist, a request for a printed version may be made so the photo can be displayed.

Farm City Week Photo Contest - Rules

Digitally altered photos are acceptable such as Instagram photos. "High Dynamic Range" images are acceptable.

No photos of pets such as dogs, cats, hamsters or images of captive animals photographed in zoos and no offensive photos, damage the environment or put any individual or animal in danger, or infringe on the rights of any other photographers or persons.

Previously published material for which non-exclusive rights were granted may be entered as long as you still maintain the right to grant us to use the photo in publications.

Photo release - If your photograph is selected as a winner, you grant the Farm City Week coalition and the Florida Thoroughbred Breeders' & Owners' Association a royalty-free, nonexclusive right, in perpetuity, to:

- Display the photo in the Gallery and at other Farm City Events and use on the internet in support of Farm City week
- Use the photograph in non-commercial communications
- Provide your photograph to other individuals and organizations for non-commercial use, in news stories, newsletters, reports, slide shows, displays, web pages, and the like.
- Use, in connection with the Photo Contest, your name, city, county, state in promotions and other publications.
- Keep the files provided, and to archive the images on CD or in other electronic forms, so that your photos can be used and be properly credited. Photographer will be given credit with the photographer's last name when the photo is published (and we are not held responsible if the name is inadvertently left out in publication)

JUDGING - Images will be judged on originality, technical excellence, composition, overall impact and artistic merit in the category they were submitted. The Farm City Week coalition shall determine winner eligibility in its sole and absolute discretion. All decisions made by the judges are final. The judging panel will select three finalists in each category and honorable mentions as necessary. The general public will select the Grand Prize Winner by popular vote from a pool of Finalists determined by the judging panel. There is a limit of one vote per person.

DEADLINE - Entries can be uploaded starting 12:01 a.m. EST on October 1, 2015. Deadline for submitting entries is Noon EST on November 1, 2015. Public voting for the grand-prize winner from the finalists in each category will be held beginning Farm City Week – starting November 7 to December 30. Public voting will be at various locations in the county. Only one vote per person, regardless of number of locations. The FTBOA Museum & Gallery, is one voting location and is open Monday –Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., closed noon to 1 pm daily and holidays. Finalists may be on display at Farm City Festival at the Ocala 4-H Farm on Nov. 15 and Ag Hall of Fame dinner on Nov. 19. The Grand Prize winner will be announced the first week of January after all votes has been collected from sites throughout the county.
